SUMMER MELT "Often times kids regress over summer vacation - both socially and academically. Re-entry in September can be an uneasy and lengthy transition." Eagala certified program director Cori Nichols points out "Here the kids are having a good time while learning how to engage with the animals - and each other. They'll head into the new school year with greater confidence and a more positive sense of self. They need that to succeed academically."

WHY HORSES? With this type of work, the horses are allowed to be as natural as possible," Nichols says. "The kids will see that their behavior has consequences." For instance, if a child runs up to a horse instead of approaching calmly, the horse naturally moves away. "They all want to be around the animals so they start realizing how they need to act to make that happen," says Nichols. Learning to pick up on non-verbal signals is a skill that comes naturally to some people, but may be a challenge for others.

Other skills addressed include listening and articulating, building trust and problemsolving. No riding is involved. No horse experience is necessary.
